

Dear Ms. Yoerger:

The Department of Public Instruction has completed its investigation into allegations that you engaged in "immoral conduct" as defined by Wisconsin Statute § 115.31(1)(c), which could result in the revocation of your professional license(s).

It is the decision of this office that there is no probable cause for the Department to pursue revocation of your license(s) at this time. Additionally, processing of your pending application will now resume. You will be contacted if any further information is needed in order to approve your pending application.

In accordance with Section 115.31(6)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes, a record of this investigation and its outcome will be maintained by the Department. If the Department of Public Instruction receives new or additional information regarding your conduct in this or in any other matter that provides evidence that your conduct endangers the health, education, safety, or welfare of any pupil, the Department would be required to re-open this matter and/or to commence a new investigation to determine whether license revocation proceedings are warranted.
